Motion was made by Alderman Simpson, and seconded by Alderman Tanksley, to approve the agenda as presented. All voting yea, motion carried.

FYE 2025 Budget Workshop

Police Chief Chandler presented his department budget requests to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Chief Chandler went over a plan for revenues and expenses to provide additional officers, raises, vehicles to replace older ones, cameras and vehicle computers. The school is wanting an additional SRO and with the agreement the school pays for 75% of the cost associated with each SRO. The dash cameras and computers for the vehicles will help the efficiency of the process for offices on the street with each situation they come across, which would in turn help Dispatch and Court if needed. The cost of the dash cameras is about \$55,000 yearly and the computers are a one time cost of \$85,000.

Fire Chief Foresman presented his department budget requests to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Chief Foresman went over revenue sources to pay for the new firetruck that was recently approved, and also requests for an increase in manpower, raises, the need for new SCBA's, a new brush truck, a vehicle to run medical calls from Station 1, a vehicle for training travel, and other expenses for renovating offices, equipment and supplies. Fire Chief Foresman also went over their call volume comparison, and justifications for the requested items.

Court Clerk Tameka Herron presented her department budget request to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Ms. Herron is requesting her part-time employee be funded for full-time, raises and some items to furnish their office lobby. Ms. Herron provided the Mayor and Board of Aldermen with a case comparison.

The Mayor and Board held a brief discussion regarding items requested.
