FYE 2025 Budget Workshop

Parks & Recreation Director Rob Boyd presented his department budget requests to the Mayor and Board. Mr. Boyd is requesting to replace two utility carts, AED's, AC upgrade for the concession trailer, flooring at playgrounds, cement work for a storage area, generator, trash can conversion, two batting cage nets and an ice machine. Mr. Boyd stated his larger and more important requests are restrooms built for the soccer fields, new lighting for fields 7/8/9, asphalt work, replacing the fence at the playground, and upgrading the old concession building.

Animal Shelter Director Kris Robinson presented her department budget requests to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Ms. Robinson is requesting a van for transporting animals to MSU for free neuter and spaying services, an increased food budget and funds for new doors to the kennels.

Public Works Director David Cooke presented his department budget requests to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Mr. Cooke is requesting to purchase a used backhoe, to increase the starting pay for his departments and pay raises for employees.

The Mayor and Board held a brief discussion regarding items requested.
